12:15 - 13:15	Lobbying - * During lobbying, the delegates of the advanced conference are able to talk about the conference. However, it will be limited in designated rooms and bilateral communication (not multi-countries communication). - For all delegates, we highly recommend talking with other delegates and deepening friendship. *For more specific information, please refer to Background Guide 2. Icebreaking session Day 1 12:00-12:30

- **Interaction only**; no policy or conference actions should be discussed.
- Getting to know one another is essential because trust and mutual understanding help keep later disagreements constructive.
- Cooperative atmosphere makes it possible to integrate differing ideas at a higher level—the core of “**Aufheben**”.



Formal Debate

- Each country has **2 minutes** to deliver a formal speech.
- This speech will be made public.
- Examples of content for speeches during the formal debate include:
 - Your country's stance
 - Policy proposals
 - Key topics for your nation or suggested discussion topics
 - Proposals for how the conference should proceed



Formal Debate

Unique to JEIMUN2026

- In JEIMUN2026, **every country** will make a speech at the beginning of the 1st Meeting.
 - When the country in the speakers list is running short, the chair will reopen the speakers list, so delegates who wish to give another speech must add their country to the list by raising their placards.
- ※When there are no countries in the speakers list, the meeting will proceed to voting. If there are no Draft Resolutions or Amendments on the floor, **the meeting will be adjourned.** (This means that the discussion will be finished.)

What is Informal Debate?

- **Moderated Caucus (Max 40 mins)**
 - Delegates should discuss the topic specified in the motion.
 - Delegates wishing to speak must raise their placards. The chair will call on one country at a time to speak.
- **Unmoderated Caucus (Max 50 mins)**
 - Delegates are allowed to move freely within the conference room.
 - Delegates prepare for WP, DR, and Amendments.

About Official Documents **✧for Beginners Conference**

- **Working Paper (2 or more sponsor countries for submission)**
 - Delegates are allowed to submit their Working Paper from **the beginning of the meeting until 11:00 of Day 3.**
- **Draft Resolution (15 or more sponsor countries for submission)**
 - Delegates should submit their DR by **15:00 of Day 2.**
 - For more explanations about DR, refer to Workshop 2!!
- **Amendments (22 or more sponsor countries for submission)**
 - Delegates should submit their Amendments by **10:00 of Day 3.**



Voting

- **Roll call vote**

- The chair will call out each country's name to ask if delegates agree or disagree with the Draft Resolution or amendment. (Answer “Yes”, “No”, “Abstention” or “Pass”)

- **Consensus vote**

- This voting indicates that all countries agree to the DR or amendment, eliminating the need for individual roll calls.
- If a delegate opposes adopting the document by consensus, they should raise their placard, in which case a roll-call vote will be conducted.

Post-conference phase

Review!!!

- Ask other delegates for your review
- **IMPORTANT:** Look back on your actions from preparation through the conference itself and consider what you could have improved.
 - “Think, think, think by yourself”

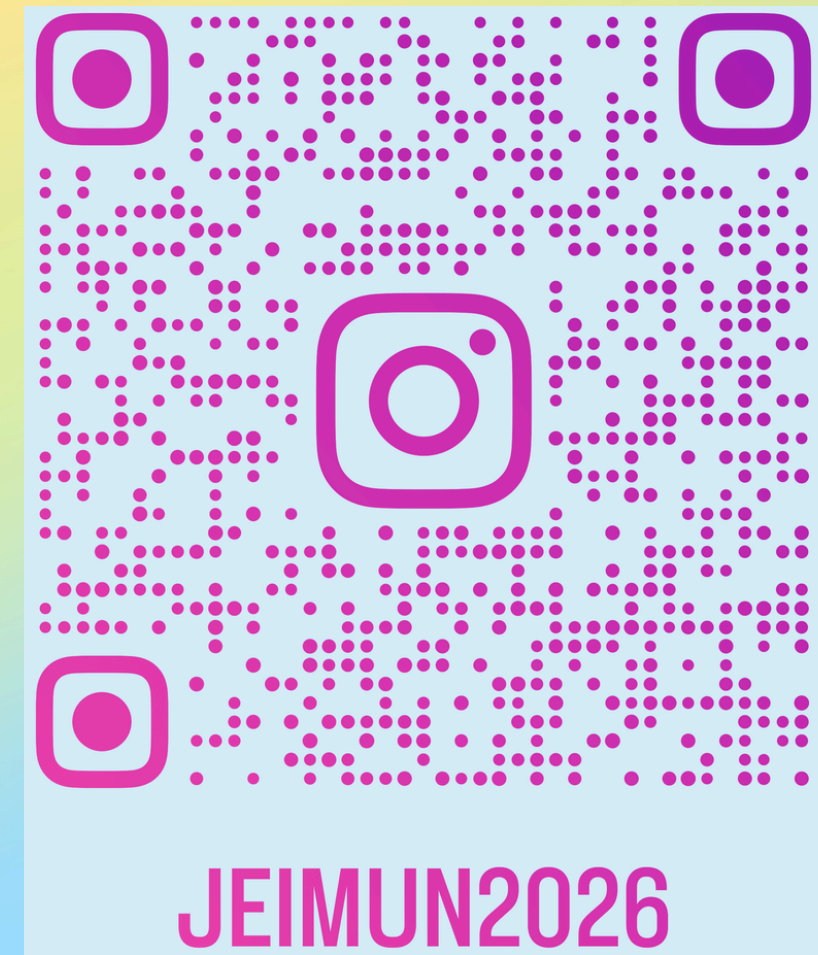
